



DOMESTIC TRANSFER MATCHING SYSTEM OVERVIEW

WHAT IS DTMS?

The FIFA Domestic Transfer Matching (**DTMS**) is a platform that is used by Member Associations to track and manage the movement of players between domestic clubs. It is very similar to the International Transfer Matching System (**ITMS**) used in the international movement of players.

HOW WILL DTMS BE USED IN AUSTRALIA?

The use of DTMS will be required for the domestic transfer of a player who is registering with their new Club as a professional. It will assist with the management and enforcement of all matters related to domestic player movement.

WHEN WILL DTMS BE IMPLEMENTED?

Football Australia is currently working with all stakeholders on an integrated implementation process for DTMS in Australia. The use of DTMS will become mandatory from the commencement of the next Registration Period, being the Men's on 11 January 2023.

BENEFITS OF THE USE OF DTMS

DTMS is a tool that connects the domestic movement of players with the international transfer market via the integration with the FIFA Connect platform. Via this connection, Australian Clubs are able to more readily access training rewards. Domestically, DTMS allows Players and Clubs to have visibility over all aspects of a player's registration, including contractual and the financial elements.
